Production / Injection Reporting Forms



- Monthly Production / Injection
 - OG110 – Monthly Production
 - OG110B – Monthly Injection
- Monthly Disposition
 - OG110D – Monthly Disposition
- SB 1281 – Water Usage (Quarterly)
 - OG110Q – Quarterly Water Production
 - OG110BQ – Quarterly Water Injection
 - OG110FQ – Quarterly Other Water Allocation
- Annual Production
 - Form 122 – Annual Production

Form Name	Purpose

OG110 Monthly Production	Form used to report monthly production data from Operators.
OG110B Monthly Injection	Form used to report monthly injection data from Operators.
OG110D Monthly Disposition	Form used to report monthly disposition data from Operators.
110BQ Quarterly Water Injection	Allows Operators to report water injection data on a quarterly basis
110FQ Quarterly Other Water Allocation	Report quarterly water allocation data
110Q Quarterly Water Production	Allows Operators to report water production data on a quarterly basis
Form 122 Annual Production	Report annual production and operations

Production / Injection Reporting Forms (cont)



- **CA Pub Res Code § 3227 (2022)**

Mandate to report production and injection fluid quantities and qualities, and number drilling, producing, injecting and idle wells.

- Reporting frequency depending on the report types:
 - Monthly **on or before the last day of each month, for the last preceding calendar month.**
 - Quarterly water usage **on or before the last day of each quarter, for the last preceding quarter.**

- **CA Pub Res Code § 3402 (2022)**

Mandate for Assessment and Collection of Charges.

- **CA Pub Res Code § 3406 (2022)**

Mandate to well owner to file an annual report with CalGEM on or before March 15th of each year.

- **CA Pub Res Code § 3407.5 (2022)**

Mandate allow CalGEM to make estimate of deficit amount of Oil and gas production under reported or not submitted by well owner.

- **CA Pub Res Code § 3408 (2022)**

Mandate to add penalty assessment for failure to file annual amount of oil and gas production report.

- **CA Pub Res Code § 3420 (2022)**

Mandate allow CalGEM impose penalty and interest on operator delinquent assessment fees.

Frequently Asked Questions – Form 122



- **When is the Form 122 – Annual Production considered Submitted to CalGEM?**
 - In WellSTAR: Form 122 – Annual Production is considered submitted after it has been certified and Submitted using Step 7: Form Submit. Submitted Form 122's are visible in the Forms Submitted Grid in WellSTAR.
 - By Mail: Form 122 – Annual Production is considered submitted by the postmarked date.
- **Can the Form 122 be submitted if Step 3: Monthly Data includes estimated volumes for Monthly reports?**
 - Yes, Form 122 is required to be submitted by March 15th.
- **Will Step 3: Monthly Data update if OG110, OG110B and OG110D forms are submitted while the Form 122 is in Progress?**
 - Yes, as Monthly reporting forms are submitted and accepted into WellSTAR, the monthly totals reflected on Step 3: Monthly Data will be updated.
- **How can the wells which have estimated monthly reports be identified?**
 - View Estimated Monthly Data by navigating to Organization Detail – Production page. Estimated monthly reports are designated by including (Est.).
